

Do you have a diabetic pet?

There is app for that!

Merck, one of our drug reps has created an app to help keep track of your pet's diabetes.

You'll be able to:

- Pick a date
- Keep track of your pet's water intake
- Keep track of your pet's food consumption
- Monitor other behavior such as:
 - Altered attitude
 - Altered behavior
 - Weakness, collapse, behavior
 - Vomiting
 - Diarrhea

Any at home Glucose Curves can be tracked and results emailed to barbourlane@gmail.com for our doctors to look at immediately.

All you have to do is go to your app store and type in 'petdiabetes' to download and get started. The best part is IT'S FREE!

If you are coming in for a Glucose curve:

Please arrive between 7:30 and 8:30 am the morning of the procedure. For dogs: DO NOT feed or give insulin that morning. For cats: Feed them in the morning but DO NOT give insulin. Please bring the following items with you:

- The insulin you are currently using
- At least 2 syringes
- The food the pet is currently eating

Your pet will stay the entire day so please leave a number where we can reach you for picking up later in the day and for any questions we may have. Be sure to tell the technician taking your pet in when the last meal was eaten, when the last dose of insulin was given, and what dose you are currently giving.
